EVENT 1 Private Driving Class

For horses & ponies, 4 years old or over, driven to a traditional or traditional type vehicle. A traditional vehicle means a vehicle of traditional profile and identifiable type to resemble the design of a carriage built prior to the First World War. The vehicle may be made from modern materials but must have traditional style springing and carriage lamps. Pneumatic tyred vehicles, trade turnouts and show wagons are not eligible. Open to Singles, Pairs or Tandems. **No Entry Fee.**

Prizes: 1st £50 & Sandy Rayne Memorial Trophy presented by Miss Mary Rayne, Aberdeen; 2nd £40; 3rd £30; 4th £20; 5th £10

Assemble in Paddock at 12.45 p.m.

EVENT 2 Exercise Vehicle

For horses & ponies, 4 years old or over. A single, pair or tandem driven to a carriage of non-traditional type design that would be driven every day for exercise and includes those with pneumatic tyres specifically designed for carriages (i.e not car tyres). Lamps need not be carried. Judging will include general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and vehicle suitability. **No Entry Fee.**

Prizes: 1st £50; 2nd £40; 3rd £30; 4th £20; 5th £10

Assemble in paddock at 1.15pm.

£100 and The Woodside Perpetual Claret Jug presented in memory of Yasmin Norrie, Woodside of Wrae, Turriff for Best Turned Out Combination and £50 to Reserve.

Turriff Show is affiliated to the British Driving Society. Points are awarded for the highest placed turnouts driven by a BDS member and count towards the Whitehall Cup & the Chairman's Cup. The British Driving Society present a Champion & Reserve Champion Rosette for the Driving Champion.

SPECIAL NOTES FOR COMPETITORS

- 1. See Livestock Schedule for full details.
- 2. Drivers should provide brief details of experience.
- 3. Each driver must carry a competent groom.
- 4. Hard hats complying with the current approved standard i.e. PAS 015 and BSEN 1384 are strongly recommended and the judge will be asked not to mark down competitors for wearing suitable head protection. All drivers/grooms/passengers under the age of 14 years MUST wear a correctly fitted hard had when in a carriage or in attendance to a turnout.
- 5. Any carriage driver, groom, or passenger, entering the competition without suitable head protection, does so at his or her own risk.
- 6. No passengers are allowed on a vehicle or carriage without a driver.
- 7. Harness will be inspected prior to class.
- 8. Copy of evidence of insurance MUST be submitted with entry form.
