#### Class 19. Jack Russell Terrier Open (1.0a)

1. Mr & Mrs A & R Gray. LOCHEIL GLENESK NAF TAF Stood alone. Rough coated white/tan compact dog of substance, oozing type, good head-shape with width, dark almond shaped eyes with a keen expression, nice ear placement, good dentition and bite, strong in neck for a youngster, good fore-chest, lovely front with tight feet, well ribbed, good angulations front and rear, nice bend in stifle, level top-line stood and moving, moved well both ways and well handled. ## Class 20. Skye Terrier Open (2,0a)

- 1. Mr & Mrs G McLoud ESGIA CRY FREEDOM Black/silver typey drop eared bitch with good bone and good coat, good head shape with nice flat drop ears, slight stop with strong muzzle, giving a nice typical expression, Dark brown eye, clean lipped, good underjaw, lovely dentition with good bit, Long strong crested neck, nice width to front with correct shoulder placement and well-padded feet, nice depth of brisket and oval shaped rib, level topline stood and moving, good muscular rear quarters, good tail carriage moved with drive & handled very well. BOB well done.
- 2. Mr & Mrs G McLoud ESGIA GLEN GARIOCH Black/Silver drop eared dog with similar attributes to first another dog of good bone and coat, enough width and good length to skull, neat drop ears, dark brown eye, good strong underjaw and clean lipped giving a great expression. Well placed dentition with good bite, (Could be cleaner) Good angulations front and back, holding a level top-line stood and on the move. Nice deep brisket with ample oval rib, moved well both ways. Preferred the overall balance of 1st today.

#### Class 21. Cesky Terrier Open (3,0a)

Mrs Daveena Thompson & Caitlin Penny Forbes KARENSBRAE WHATEVER Dark Blue/Grey bitch of good type with ample bone, lovely triangular headed dog, another with correct skull muzzle ratio, distinct stop with large nostrils, good keen expression, neat pendulous ears, round dark enough eye, clean in lip with mouth housing good clean dentition with good bite, nice length of neck, good angulations front and rear, good spring of rib, correct topline with slight raise to rear quarters, nice tuck-up, moved with drive and handled well. BOB and Group 3. well done.
- **2.** Mrs Daveena Thompson & Caitlin Penny Forbes **KARENSBRAE BEEBOP** Blue/Gray bitch of good type with ample bone, greyer around the muzzle and legs than 1st, similar attributes wide skull, round brown eye, clean in lip, good under-jaw, good width to front, with straight columns of support, with good tight feet, good angulations front and rear with a level top-line stood and moving, moved ok handled well. Preferred the better movement of 1<sup>st</sup> today.

Mrs Julie Gray ABERSTAFF MERRY OF SOUL Red/white skewbald, typey bitch with good bone and super pigmentation, great head shape with correct skull muzzle ratio, broad skull, deep through with neat enough ears, good mouth with a strong under jaw, dark round eye with dark rims giving a look at me expression, tidy front with tight feet turning out slightly like they naturally should be, well off for rib with nice width, short coupled, level top-line stacked & moving, strong well angled backend with nice bend of stifle and good tail-set, moved parallel fore and aft, handled very well. I was pleased to award her BOB and Group 4. Well done

Mr David Wilson **BAALZSTARZ ZIBAL** Top sized dog, dark brindle with white on chest, toes and back of neck, another typey example, nice head shape, good skull muzzle ratio with neat ears, dark round eye leading to a good typical expression, good angulations front and rear, level top-line with a nice spring of rib, nice tight feet, up on pasterns, he moved very well both ways. Handled well. Preferred the height and shorter coupling of 1<sup>st.</sup> still 2 well put together Staffords.

Nice head-shape, dark almond eye, shallow in stop, clean in lip, well-proportioned ears level with eye, good length of neck, muscular and flowing into shoulders, tidy front, tight feet, good topline on the move and stood, nice bend of stifle, good tail carriage, free and easy mover with good drive from the rear. handled well. Was pleased to award her Any Variety Terrier Puppy & Terrier Group 1.

Mrs Mildred Robertson CORNTON SUMMER SPECIAL Cream cairn terrier dog of good type with a descent head and good bone, nice length in neck flowing into well laid shoulders, good well sprung ribs leading to a good tuck-up and strong rear quarters, moved well both ways, Handled well. Lacked the sparkle of 1<sup>st</sup> today.
