Hungarian Pumi Open (1) 1st & BOB Smith's B Breezelyn Ear Say. Correctly balanced head with dark eye and good ear carriage. Short firm back. Moved Well.

Rough Collie Grad 3 (1) 1st Shorten's Thistlewings Andromeda At Bracoisla. Upstanding two year old sable and white showy male of correct size and type. Good length of head. Strong bone. Good hard feet. Shown in good body and excellent coat. Moved soundly and showed his ears to advantage when standing in show pose. 2nd Milne's Stregato My Highland Dancer. Year old tricolour male - again of correct classic type. Good intense black with attractive tan and white markings. Soundly put together with good bone and substance. Living up to his name he was a bit unsettled on the day which was just due to youthful exuberance.

Rough Collie Post Grad 5(1) 1st Thistlewings Andromeda At Bracoisla. 2nd Crawford's sable and white Stregato Foolish Guy. Yet another upstanding classic type male Collie. Well up to size with correct length of body Good dentition and long balanced head with nice dark eye. Excellent length of tail reaching past his hock joint. Moved soundly but just a little unsettled both on the move and when standing. 3rd Haslam-Craib's sable & white B Roughrigg Ragga.

Rough Collie Open 6(2) 1st BOB and Working Group 1. Swinton Raven's four year old Blue Merle D Corydon Ice Imperial. A handsome male again of correct classic collie type with excellent head which had a well filled muzzle correct set, size and shape of eye and the slight but perceptible stop the standard asks for at the centre point of balance of length of head. Good reach of neck, correct length of body to height and in great coat and condition. Nicely broken blue coat of correct blue colour - so important in a merle. Moved soundly and stood and showed perfectly non stop. This was certainly his day.2nd Brodie's sable and white Shannaburn Country Road. At almost three years old he is a mature male shown in excellent coat and condition. A different type of collie from the winner as he is somewhat shorter in both head and body with a deeper stop but still quite striking and not to be ignored. Well presented and handled by his two handlers he moved very soundly and showed well on the day. But today he was eclipsed by a dog who stood above him and went on to win the group. So there should be no disgrace in standing second to the class winner. 3rd Stregato Foolish Guy

Bearded Collie Post Grad 2 (0)1st Ryan's Dychix Invictus For Razkal. Mature four year old male . Good head Correct bite. Well made and shown in good body and coat. Moved Soundly. 2nd Savage's Strufingill Penny Benjamin at Canaich. 6 month old attractive and promising puppy bitch who has everything there. A little playful and unsettled on the day which will no doubt pass with age and experience.

Bearded Collie Open 5(2) 1st & BOB Gill & Hosie's Ch Burnhock Superior Diamong for Gillaber. Very well made mature male shown in excellent body coat and condition. Soundly constructed. Full of ring presence. Moved with drive. 2nd Higgins' B Allachoy Isle of Neave Another good quality exhibit with all the right things who moved soundly and showed well. Just overshadowed by qualities and ring presence of winner. 3rd Savage & McLean's D Talraz Comic Relief at Canaich.

Shetland Sheepdog Grad 7(2) 1st BOB & PG4 Main's B Shenachie Lyric Fantasy. Attractive S/W Yearling B with excellent eye giving such a sweet expression. Soundly constructed Shown in good body coat and condition. Moved and showed well. 2nd Main and Simpson's D Shenachie Secretariat. Litter brother to the winner and very similar but obviously more masculine otherwise same comments apply. Just not quite the overall panache of his sister on the day but gave her a close run. 3rd Saunders' B Leterikhills River Star Over Torriglen

Shetland Sheepdog Post Grad 4(1) 1st Saunders D Galateus Bohemia Classic at Torriglen (Imp CZE). Mature male shown in good body coat and condition. Moved soundly and showed well. Brodie & Rathell's B Shanaburn Strawberry Wine Attractive bitch with sweet expression who did all that was asked of her. Gave winner a close run. 3rd Munro's B Richmaus Tilly.

Shetland Sheepdog Open 4(0)1stMain's B Shenachie Lyric of Light . Very attractive nine year old who defies her years. Good head. Profuse coat Sound mover but had to give way to youth in the BOB challenge. 2nd Forbes' Wellneuk Dancing Flame JW SHCM. A nice 8 year old sable and white bitch again with all the correct head eye and ear properties of winner so gave her a close run. But in the end I was seduced by the winners more profuse coat. 3rd Main's B Shenachie Flakey Dove.

Border Collie Graduate 2(0) 1st Rettie's Glenfound Future Hope Handsome young black and white male puppy with nice coat markings. Soundly constructed Good length of tail. Moved confidently and soundly. 2nd Kempton's Borderbrook Lucky in Love. Attractive feminine puppy bitch who has everything she needs. Just unlucky to be against the more showy male who took the class on the day.

Border Collie Post Graduate 2(0) 1st Rettie's B. Glenfound Future Hope. Well put together mature two year old black and white bitch with good dentition who moved soundly and with drive. 2nd Kempton's Gorgeous Gia Borders Via Border brook (Imp Aus). A three year old bitch of quite similar type and construction. Just preferred overall qualities of winner but a close run thing.

Border Collie Open 4(3) 1st and BOB Rettie's Borderbrook Fame or Fortune SHCEX. The title echoes her name quite possibly with more to follow. Exquisite bitch with classic attractive head. Sound construction and positively glided round the ring. Stood out with perfect stance showing off all her properties and just asking to be chosen. 2nd Holmes' D Meisterwerk Artful Dodger. Another quality exhibit with good bone correct conformation and sound movement. Shown in good coat and condition. Just preferred overall qualities of class winner. 3rd Rettie & Morley's D Chikaramor Cast A Spell of Glenfound.

OES Post Grad 2(0) 1st McIntosh's B Blairdon A Wee Deoch An Doris. Attractive two year old square bodied. feminine B shown in lovely coat and condition. Nice head and expression. Soundly constructed and this was shown to advantage when she moved. 2nd Forbes' Junior D dog Aberdream Yours Only George. Half bother to winner and of similar type and quality. Masculine and well up to size. Has all the right properties. Very slightly over exuberant but at just a year old this can be expected.

OES Open 2(1) 1st & BOB Mcintosh's Amblehay Ace of Heart At Blairdon. Mature eight year old who belies his age. Soundly constructed and correct in all respects. Well handled shown and presented. The sire of the two placings in my previous class.

Welsh Corgi(Pem) Open 4(0) 1st & BOB Franchi's Saniaquinto Black Diamond. Handsome male tri with good dentition correct foxy expression nice dark eye and good topline. Moved soundly. 2nd Chrystall's Nesden Beinn Dearg. Nice foxy red and white male who caught my eye right away but lost out to winner as I felt he was carrying just a tad too much weight. 3rd Ranchi's B Saniaquinto Moonstruck.

GSD Open 5(0) 1st BOB and PG2 Smeaton's Lorgyle Arran. Upstanding well made mature male in excellent hard body good coat and condition. Good dentition and correct balance of head. Good angulation Moved soundly and held his correct topline whilst on the move. 2nd Reid's Kleehuegel Hope At Portnall. Attractive yearling B who will doubtless mature even more as she ages but is still at present a very nice example of her breed. 3rd Robertson's B Forguecroft Feisty Lady.

Samoyed Post Grad 5(3) 1st & BOB Gregor & McWilliam's Istramac Shining Illuka. Attractive lively male with great friendly temperament. Good head and expression Shown in good body feet and legs. 2nd Gregor & McWilliam's B Istramac Toories Lass. Litter sister to winner and of similar type and quality with good pigment. But as is often the case in mixed classes the dog takes the upper hand being generally bigger and that bit showier. 3rd Scott-May's MPB Croftdouglas Dileas Anam.

Samoyed Open 2(0) 1st Gregor and McWilliam's Istramac Serendipity. This bitch has everything. Good head and mouth with nice tight lips. Exquisite expression, excellent body coat and condition. Moved soundly and confidently. 2nd Milne's Lumistarr This Is How We Do It. Upstanding male who gave winner a close run. Everything about him was good too but he just lacked that extra bit of sparkle of the winner.

Briard Open 3(2) 1st & BOB Nelson's B Gilcoru L'Interdit D'Brie. Classy attractive bitch. Good mouth square muzzle and correctly proportioned head.

Shown in good body and coat. Sound on the move.

Australian Shepherd Post Grad 3(1) 1st & BOB Webster's Louiston Hellfire Handsome quality male with good head properties Shown in good body and coat. Moved well. 2nd Macdonald's Trust N You Baby of Blue Rimrock with Donurie (Imp Fra). Attractive bitch. Another sound specimen who moved well. Slightly younger than winner and just losing out to him on overall maturity.

Australian Shepherd Open 4(1) 1st Wilson's Roschell Blue Whisper. Mature soundly constructed two year old male with good movement. Just referred head properties of BOB winner in challenge. 2nd Gall's D Benreeda Dingo Dollar. Nice male shown in good body and coat. Lost out to winner on movement on the day. 3rdMacdonald & Crawford's B Louiston Whispered A Dream with Donurie.

AV Past NSC Post Grad 1(0) 1st Shorten's Smooth Collie Glencorrie Stella Bark at Bracoisla. Exquisite feminine sable & white puppy bitch who must surely have a promising future. Good mouth with correct scissor bite. Well filled muzzle with slight but perceptible stop and flat back skull. Good reach of neck and strong level back with correct tail carriage. Excellent front and rear angulation with good hard feet. Still very much a baby with a bit of maturing to do just as one should expect in this breed at that age. Sound and confident movement. Stood and showed well.

AV Past NSC Open 1(0) 1st Best Past AVNSC and Past Group 3. Rennie's Smooth Collie Diamondfox Sir Galahad (Imp Fin). Mature handsome two year old male in hard muscular condition. It is rare to see this 'numerically at risk' breed exhibited in Scotland, and it also seems to me that most UK smooth exhibits unlike their rough coated counterparts - are not sables, so all the more surprising to find two such high quality specimens here today. He has all the right points. Good head and eye. Good depth of chest. Correct reach of neck. Good length of tail. Nice bend of stifle and shown in good hard condition. Moved with drive as expected from his construction and stood and showed well.

AV Past Minor Puppy 4(0) 1st Scott-May's Croftdouglas Dileas Anam Beautiful Samoyed 6 month old bitch with excellent pigment and a wonderful happy nature. Soundly constructed and moved perfectly. Shown in good body and coat. Must surely have a promising future. One to watch. 2nd Kempton's Art of Blossom Drowned In Emotion Into Borderbrook NAF (Imp ESP). Handsome young male well put together. Shown in good body and coat. Very sound mover. Just unlucky to meet winner on the day. 3rd Glenfound Future Hope. **AV Past Puppy** 5(1) 1st Glencorrie Stella Bark 2nd Borderbrook Lucky In Love. 3rd Richmous Daisy Delight. AV Past Veteran 1194) 1st Amblehay Ace of Heart at Blairdon 2nd Yule's nine year old sable and white Rough Collie B Ingledene Gold Lace. Impressive Sable and white of correct size and type and still looking a good specimen of her breed. Good length of head with well filled muzzle and flat back skull. Nice reach of neck and good front and rear quarters. Moved soundly and stood and showed with impassive dignity. 3rd Shenochie Lyric of Light.

St Bernard Open 2(1) Ist & BOB Jenkins St Bernard D Chandlimore Right Said Fred. Nicely marked male puppy with superb temperament. Just needs time to fully develop and settle in his construction and movement - as one might reasonably expect with a young puppy of this breed. Well handled and shown.

Boxer Post Grad 3(2) 1st Anderson's Bessbox Bombay at Wilco (IKC). Three year old B with good head and alert expression. Soundly constructed and in good body and coat. Moved well.

Boxer Open 3(1) 1st BOB and Working Group 2 Lafferty's Greenawell Lorenzo (SH CEX). Handsome upstanding three year old male with showy white markings. Good head. Correct front and rear angulation and shown in good hard condition. Moved smartly and with drive. Very well handled and presented.

Dobermann Post Grad 3(2) 1st Williamson's Kentwone Resolve and Faith. Strongly built male with good head and correct dentition. Moved soundly once given the chance to settle.

Dobermann Open 4(2) 1st BOB and Working Group 3. Verrall's Grafmax Oberon at Camperdown JW. Classical three year old mature male. Well muscled up. Good front and rear angulation plus excellent topline which he held on the move.

Rottweiler Open 6(3) 1st BOB & WG4 Bunton's Jacraila Valdemar. Handsome 5 year old mature male with all the right points. Correct head and dentition. Good body feet and legs. Nice level topline. Moved soundly and showed well. 2nd Bunton's D Siettor Look Of Love Another nice specimen of the breed. Similar in type to winner and with plenty of animation but just lacked winners overall size and was a bit less settled on the day. 3rd Bunton's D Siettor Moment In Time. **Hovawort Post Grad** 3(2) 1st & BOS Wolfe's Fasskoleys Cadmium Scarlett IKC. Nine year old B in good coat and condition that belies her years Soundly constructed. Plenty of animation. A happy showgirl who moved soundly and stood and showed well

Hovawort Open 3(1) 1st & BOB Tyerman & Challoner's Farmwatch Snow Shadow. Mature five year strongly made old male. Well up to size. Soundly constructed and moved soundly enough if just the very slightest tad unsettled - though this I forgave him. 2nd Wolfe's Ozzy Aldeon with Tussakariver. (Imp Svk) A four year old male of slightly smaller proportions than winner - but whose problem on the day was that he was over exited and unsettled jumping about on the move - so had to pay the penalty for his high spirits on the day.

AV Working NSC Post Grad 6(0) A well filled strong class. 1st Badowski's Russian Black Terrier bitch Julietta Niger Venustas (Imp Pol). Just a few weeks short of her second birthday. Attractive upstanding bitch of correct proportions. Soundly constructed. Moved and showed well. 2nd Nicoll's Tib Mastiff . Well built junior male with a gorgeous temperament who has all the right points. Happy at his work in the ring. Moved well. 3rd Jenkins Leonberger D Hillhaven Reason To Believe at Islamorada.

AV Working NSC Open 6(1) Ist Best AV Working NSC & Working Grp 1 O'Donnell's Russian Black Terrier Kalaslane Revenge For Neukiebear (IKC) SHCEX Mature six year old bitch shown in excellent body, coat and condition. Soundly constructed and her movement backed that fact up. Well handled and presented. Quality in this breed very high today. 2nd Julietta Niger Venustas (Imp Pol) 3rd Method Man

AV Working Minor Puppy 2(1) 1st Chandlimore Right Said Fred At Islamorada

AV Working Veteran 7(5) 1st Gutjahr's Hovawart Zwartbos Arreton. Astonishingly youthful thirteen year old Blonde bitch who certainly belied her years. Despite her long wait for her class she was still alert and sprightly. A good all round specimen shown in good coat and condition who showed well and moved smartly and soundly. 2nd Wolfe's Hovawort bitch Zwartbos Ventor. Litter sister to the above and colour apart very similar though just not quite as smart on the move as her sister. But sound just the same and no disgrace to her at that age.
