PG (3)1: Mccord's Kelansue Foos yer Doos A tri coloured bitch sweet head good ear placement, deep chest, well ribbed, moved well 2: Mcintosh's Kelansue Mischief Maker A nice headshape, good keel. Legs well under, she really needs to loose some weight to be appreciated this spoils her outline especially in profile

O (7,3) 1: Mcintosh's Kelansue Little Bit Norty Pleasing head, dark eye, shoulders ok tight feet, level topline, good tail set when settled moved well in good condition BOB 2: Cruickshank's Burnvale Dazzling Diamond at Culsalmond Up to size good skull shape with pronounced occiput, well ribbed, nicely angulated quarters, moved ok

G (4,2) 1: Smith's Marvidara Driver at Cardinghill Pleasing head masculine but not overdone, nice shape, correct topline and under line, moved with purpose true coming and going 2: Smith's Marvidara Something Blue at Cardinghill A nine year old bitch in lovely condition for her age, a nice size soft expression moved smartly

PG (2) 1: Ballantyne's Cobyco Catch Twenty Two at Speymalt Masculine head, long neck, good bone, tight feet correct size pleasing shape, moved well doing enough to win the class 2: Wood's Cotherstone Ayres Rock A nice type pleasing shape, well angulated, in hard condition just out moved today

O (3,1) Brander's Windwalker Heart of Gold A curvy do , who presented a lovely curvy outline, good front assembly deep chest good spring of rib moved well in every direction, well presented BOB 2: Parerson's Wheelspin Painted Lady A five year old male, of a larger mould, masculine but not course, I just preferred the front assembly of first and his better reach

O (3,1) 1: Spence's Caraidanam Bruach Na Frithe at Brylach A three three old Bitch Correct size in good coat and condition, well boned, a nicely put together nothing overdone covered the ground well BOB G2 2: Swanson's Ch Cotherstone Dallas Dhu of Altimarlach A mature lady who in her prime would have been a force to reckon with just not as steady on her pins now and out moved by younger lady
